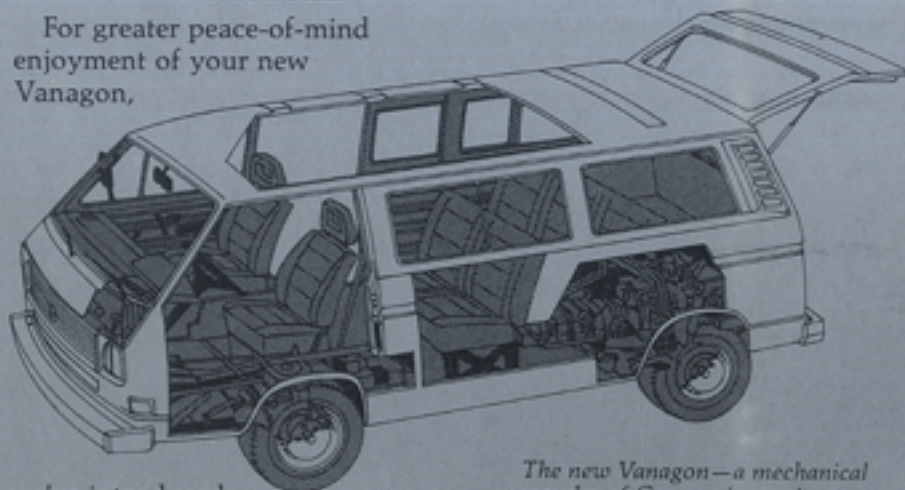

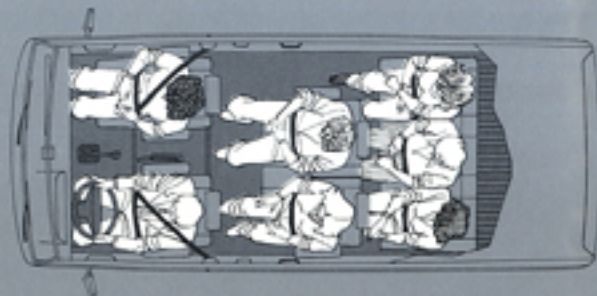


The Vanagon's power is generated by a 1.9 liter Water Boxer engine with a 4-speed manual transmission. The Vanagon's advanced engineering includes both rack and pinion steering and 4-wheel independent suspension. The result is a responsiveness, handling and driver control more akin to a sedan than a van.

Inside, a huge space awaiting seven passengers and 49.7 cubic feet of cargo, is richly appointed with standard comfort features. Padded

Since everyone's driving needs differ, we have included a complete selection of options that will help you equip your Vanagon to meet your personal preferences.

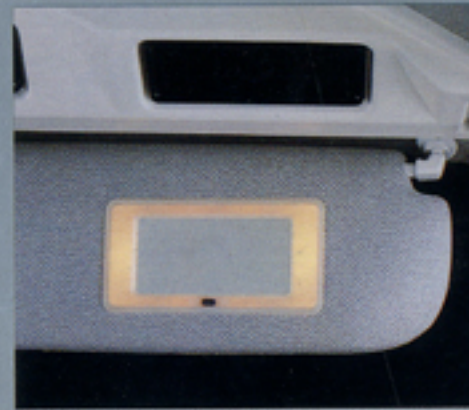
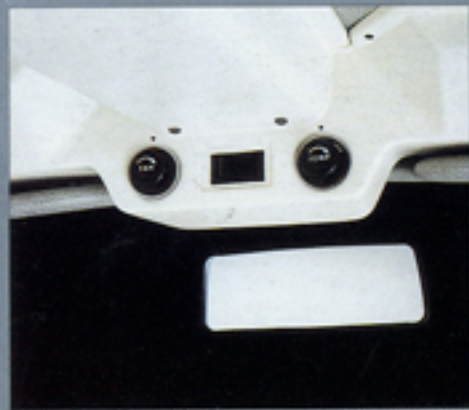
