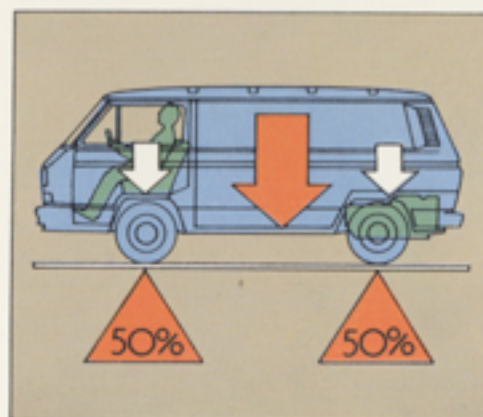

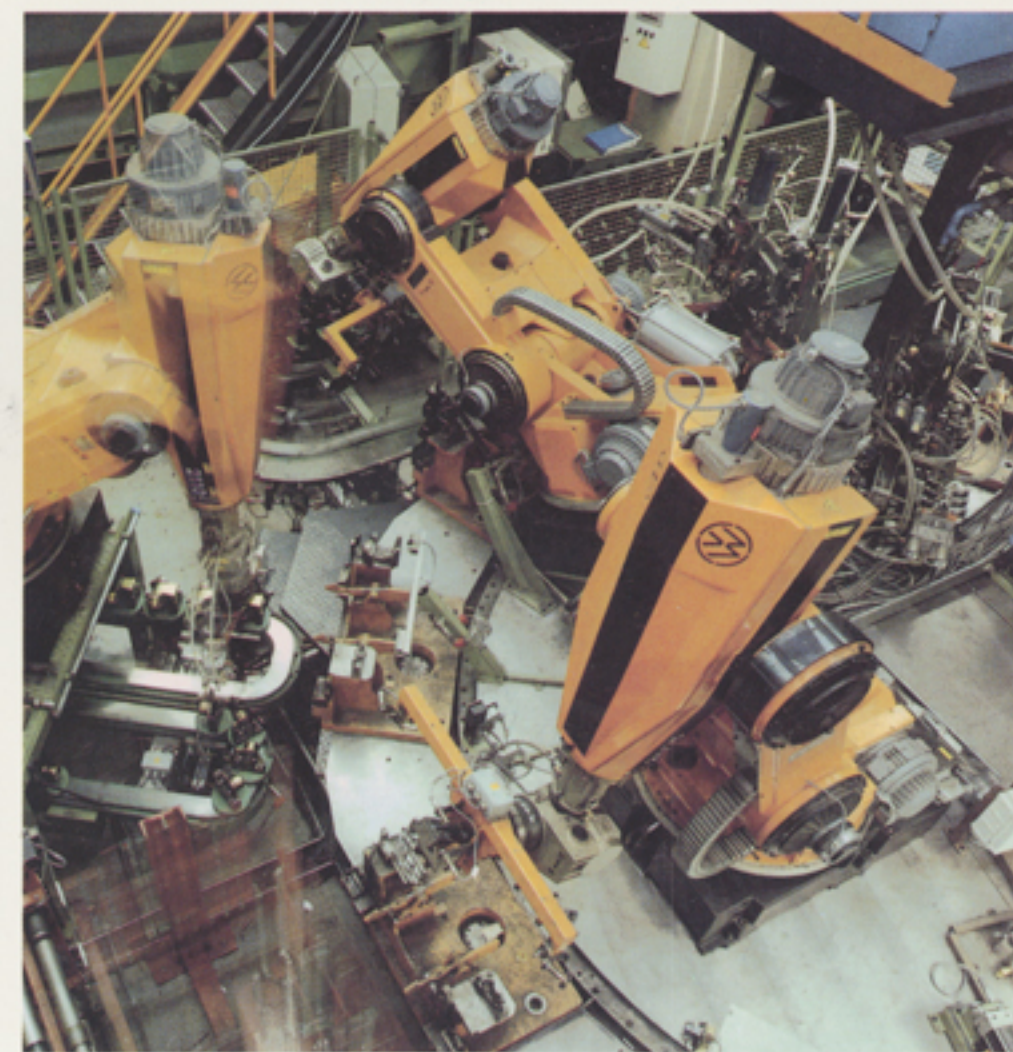
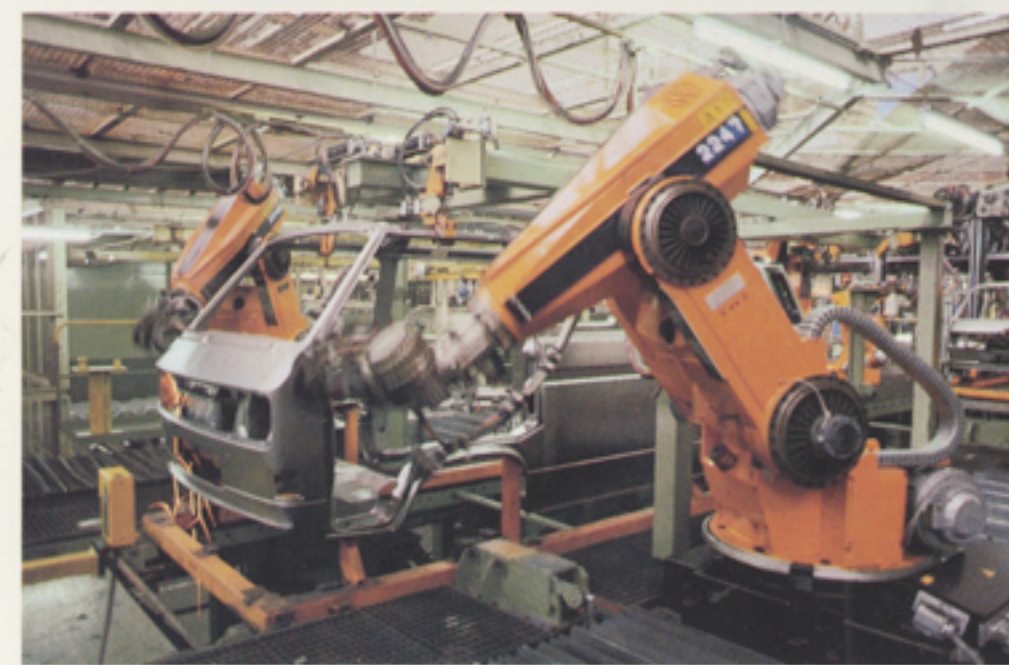
The Volkswagen Vanagon's engine, transmission and final drive are located over the rear wheels for better vehicle weight distribution, and for steering and handling ease.

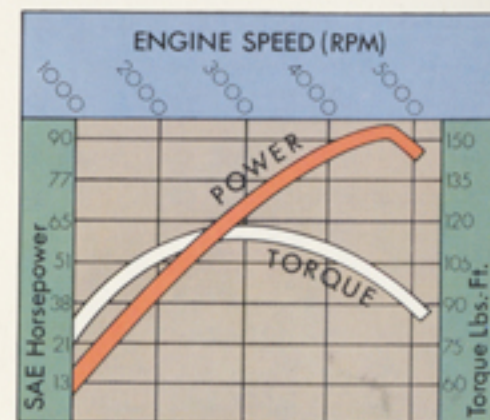

Today, there is a line of Vanagon models uniquely de-



signed to meet your individual driving and recreational needs. The Vanagon GL and new luxurious Vanagon Carat are 7-passenger vans that offer an enormous amount of performance, comfort and cargo space. The Camper GL is a one-of-a-kind family van during the week that turns into a home away from home when you head for

the hills on the weekend.

And since our German engineers always seem to find a way to make a good thing even better, they've developed the Vanagon GL Syncro 4WD and Camper GL Syncro 4WD. Both vehicles are engineered with permanent and automatic four wheel drive to provide greater traction and directional control

under an endless variety of road and weather conditions. This is the kind of innovation and versatility that gives all of the Volkswagen Vanagons a value unmatched by any other passenger van.

The energy source of the Vanagon GL is a dynamic 2.1 liter water-cooled Digifant fuel-injected engine coupled with a

4-speed transmission. A fully independent suspension increases driver control and comfort. Power rack and pinion steering keeps handling responsive and reassuring. Power front disc brakes provide sure, straightline stops. And steel belted radial tires add road-gripping ability.

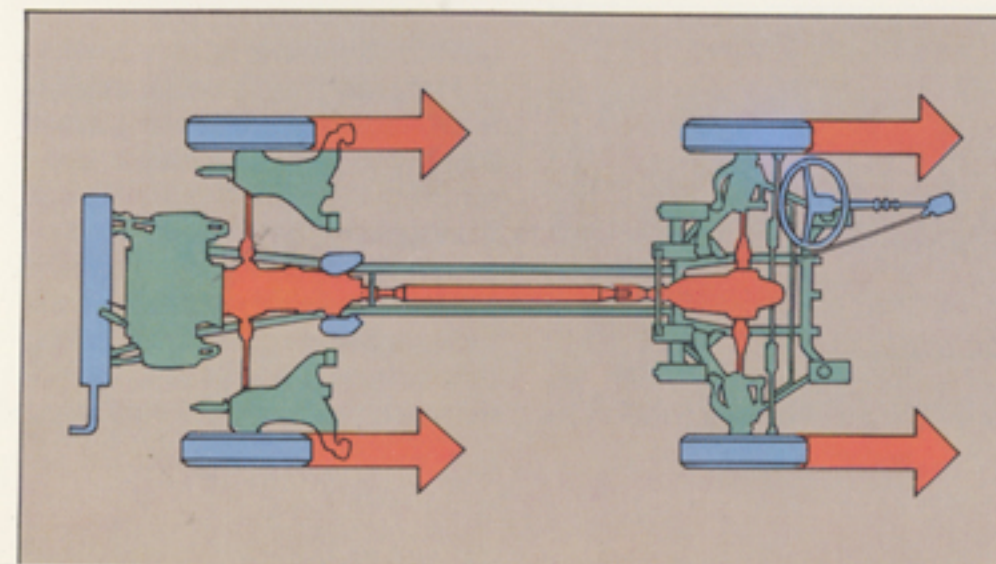

Driving a Vanagon GL is a particularly gratifying experience. Its engineering dynamics generate the kind of performance that translates into increased peace-of-mind and driver control. The new attractively designed Vanagon Carat includes unique grey body side panels, weight-reducing cast alloy wheels, metallic paint and a specially

designed interior.

The Vanagon GL Syncro 4WD and Camper GL Syncro 4WD further increase the dimension of overall driving balance. Here is how the Syncro 4WD system works. Normally, the rear wheels are the driving force on the Vanagon. If these wheels begin to lose traction, a special viscous coupling that acts like a locking

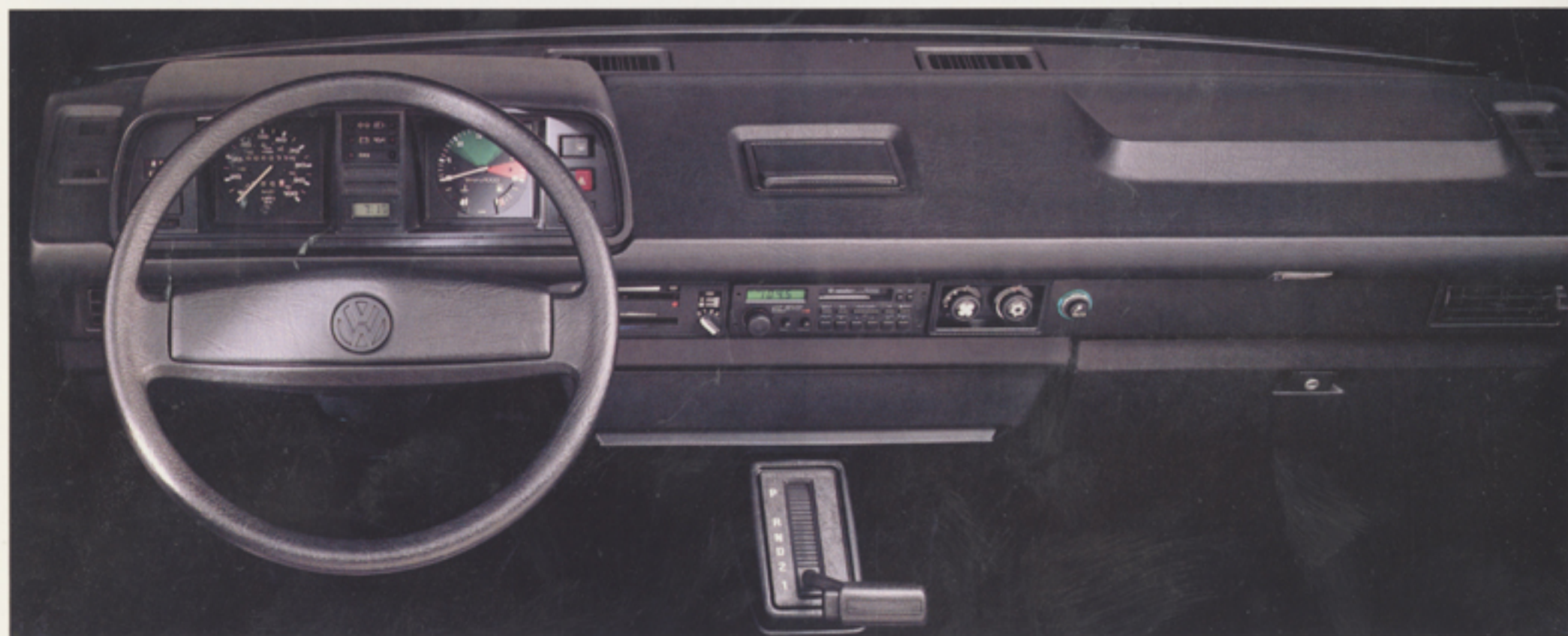


differential begins to transfer power to the front wheels. This permanent four wheel drive system engages smoothly and automatically whenever it senses a difference in speed between the front and rear axles. The result is dramatically improved traction and directional control. To use this four wheel capability to the fullest, the Syncro

4WD models provide an extra low gear for better start-up traction, larger tires and higher ground clearance, plus an 18.4 gallon fuel tank.

The Volkswagen Vanagons may be built to carry a lot of people and things, but they still supply plenty of room for performance.

The Vanagon GL and Carat feature 7-passenger comfort with velour seats and fold-down extendable armrests.



How to comfortably fill a great big room.

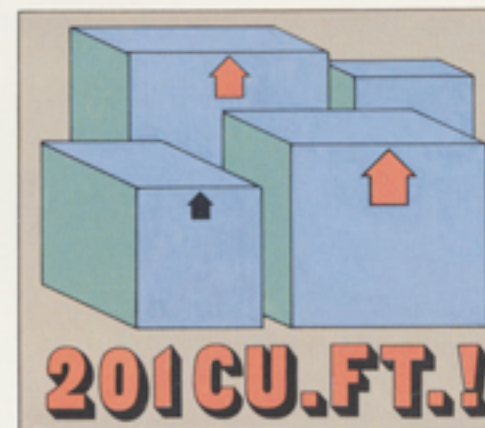
The interior of the Vanagon GL is one of the most expansive on the road. There's enough room to transport seven passengers in comfort, plus an extremely generous 49.7 cubic feet of cargo space. If you need more room, the rear seat folds down to provide extra storage. By removing the center seat, the cargo area can be expanded to

a full 201 cubic feet!

The comfortable velour seating features deep-contoured bucket seats with fold-down adjustable armrests for both the driver and front passenger. Security and convenience is increased by a fully padded dash with an illuminated, lockable glovebox. Driving distractions are kept to a minimum with a rear window

defroster, dual remote controlled mirrors, intermittent wipers, tinted glass and see-through head restraints.

Getting in and out of the Vanagon GL's bright and airy interior is easy thanks to a wide, sliding side door. Sliding windows let the fresh air in, while wall-to-wall glass gives a clear view out. When the weather turns



cold, a front and rear heater with flow-through ventilation will keep everyone nice and warm.

The new Vanagon Carat sets its own standard of comfort and versatility. Located behind the front seat are removable rear-facing seats that can fold up when not in use. A folding table stores against the side panel. And the rear bench seat can be con-

verted into a double bed. The Vanagon Carat also offers a rear window wiper and washer, power mirrors, plus the security of a central locking system.

Since people who own Vanagons tend to spend a lot of time in them, our engineers are pleased to make their stay as pleasant as possible.

The Camper GL is the kind of vehicle you'll find yourself using all the time. It serves as the perfect family van around town, and turns into a home when you're ready to escape to the great outdoors.

Driving to the campgrounds in the Camper GL is half the fun. A lively 2.1 liter Digifant fuel-injected engine teamed with a

4-speed transmission provides ample power to move this home-on-wheels briskly along. Contemporary engineering features like a fully independent suspension, power rack and pinion steering and power front disc brakes produce the kind of handling and maneuverability you'll need on those back country roads that take you



away from it all.

When the road surface becomes unfriendly, the Camper GL Syncro 4WD is the ideal camping companion to have along. When it senses a difference in speed between the front and rear axles, the permanent four-wheel drive switches on smoothly to give you better traction and improved

directional control.

The Camper GL Syncro 4WD is also fitted with an extra low gear for better start-up traction. Larger tires and higher ground clearance help clear obstructions. And an 18.4 gallon fuel tank that cuts down the worry about looking for the next gas station.

It's the weekend. And even though you've left home for the middle of nowhere, you don't have to leave the comforts of home. Because the Camper GL is furnished with a thoughtful array of household amenities.

The comfort begins with a unique pop top roof with a skylight that lets light in and protective netting that keeps bugs out.

When the troops get hungry, you can prepare gourmet dishes in the well-equipped kitchenette. You can cook on a two-burner LP gas stove, wash the dishes in a sink supplied by a 10.5 gallon water tank and keep your groceries fresh in a gas/electric refrigerator and food cupboard. face a swing out table. The rear bench seat and folding side table provide another comfortable setting for your dining enjoyment.

When it's time to retire, you have a choice of two sleeping areas. An upper double bunk under the raised pop top, and a lower double bed that's revealed by folding down the rear bench seat.

The Camper GL also gives you something you can never get enough of: storage space. There's a 3-door clothes locker. An overhead all-purpose cabinet. A pantry with a utensil drawer. Plus several other storage cabinets. Outside, a roof top storage rack adds to your carrying capacity.

Volkswagen engineers wanted

to make sure that the time you spent in the Camper GL was as worry-free as possible. So they installed convenient outside water and electric hook-ups. Made the cut pile carpeting removable for easy cleaning. Added curtains to insure your privacy. And provided a fire extinguisher in case of an emergency.

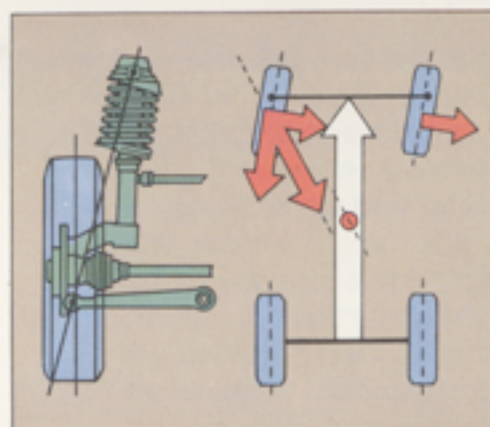

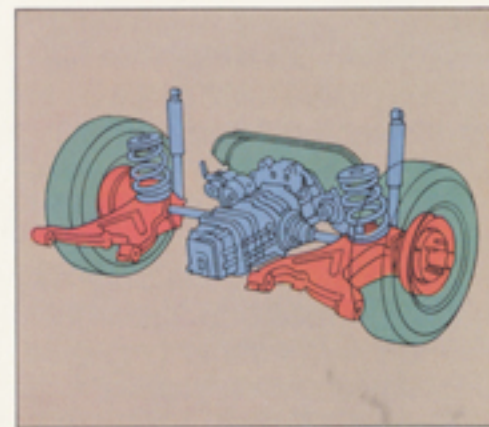

The Volkswagen Vanagon's semi-trailing arm rear suspension features independently mounted coil springs and double-action shock absorbers to provide accurate guidance of the rear wheels for better tracking and long tire life.



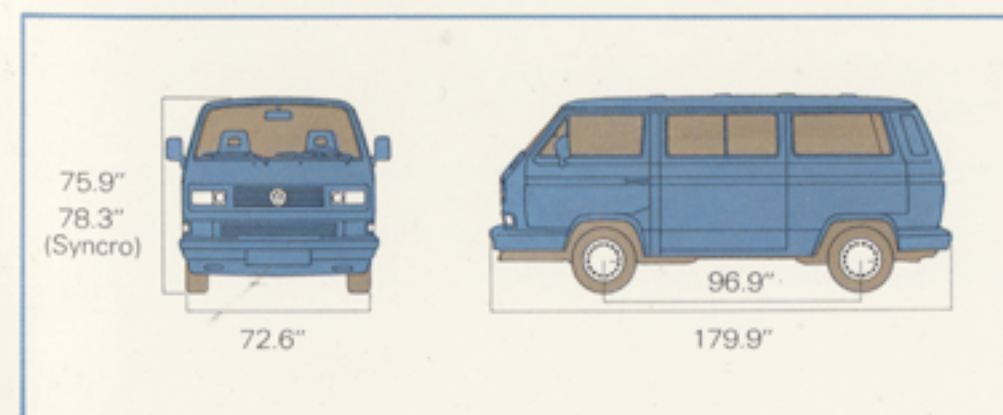
